##### **Day 1: Romantic Prague**

### Day 3: Brno – Lednice / Valtice

Guided tour through Brno incl. Villa Tugendhat (designed by famous German architect Ludwig Mies van der Rohe in the late 1920's), excursion to the South Moravian town of Lednice with a visit to the castles and parks of Lednice and Valtice, dinner in the historic vaulted cellar in Brno.

### Day 4: Kromeriz – Olomouc – Litomysl

Guided tour through city and castle in Kromeriz with Congress Room, castle gardens and flower garden, guided city tour of Olomouc with plague column, onwards journey to Litomysl, visit of the city and castle, overnight in the area of Litomysl/Hradec Kralove/Pardubice, dinner at the hotel

### Day 5: Zdar nad Sazavou – Kutna Hora – Prague

Visit of the baroque pilgrimage church of St. John of Nepomuk in Zdar nad Sazavou, city tour of Kutna Hora – the richest and most significant town of Bohemia throughout the Middle Ages - with the Valachian courtyards and the gothic Cathedral of St. Barbara, 2 nights in Prague.
